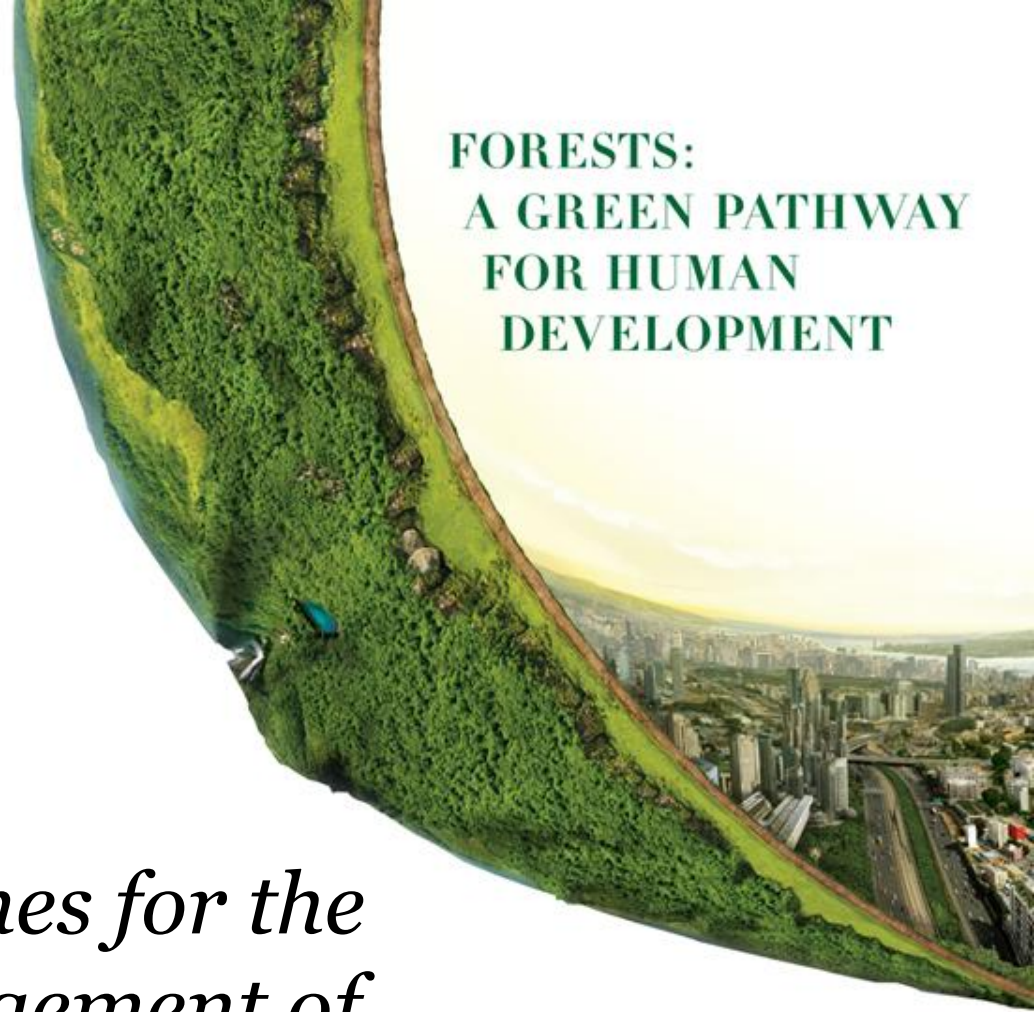

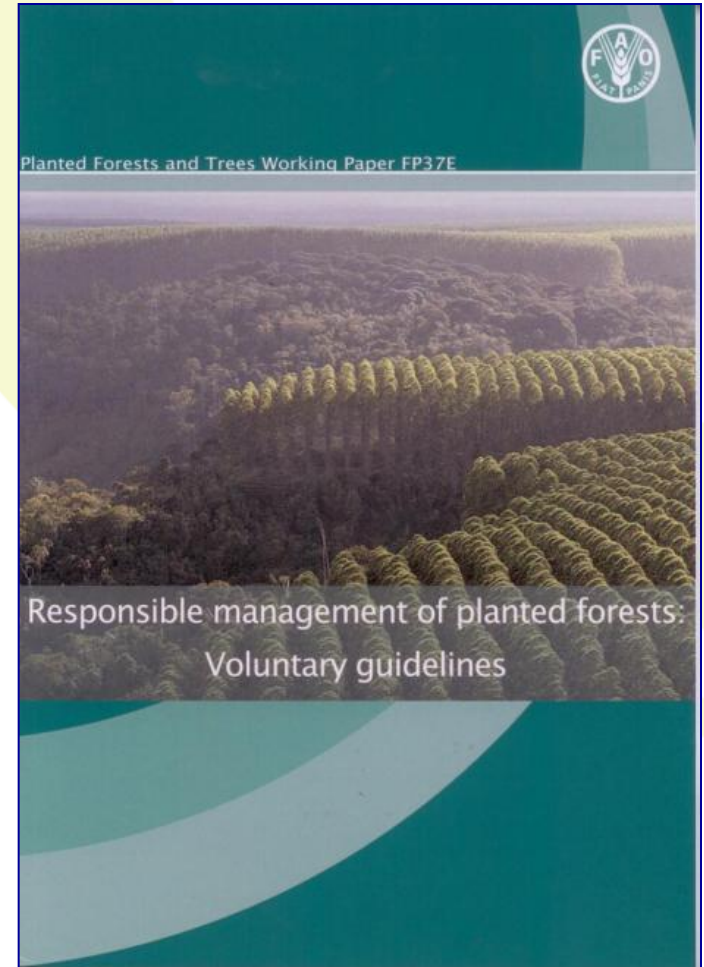


Process

Provides a political, regulatory, economic and technical framework of principles & guidelines

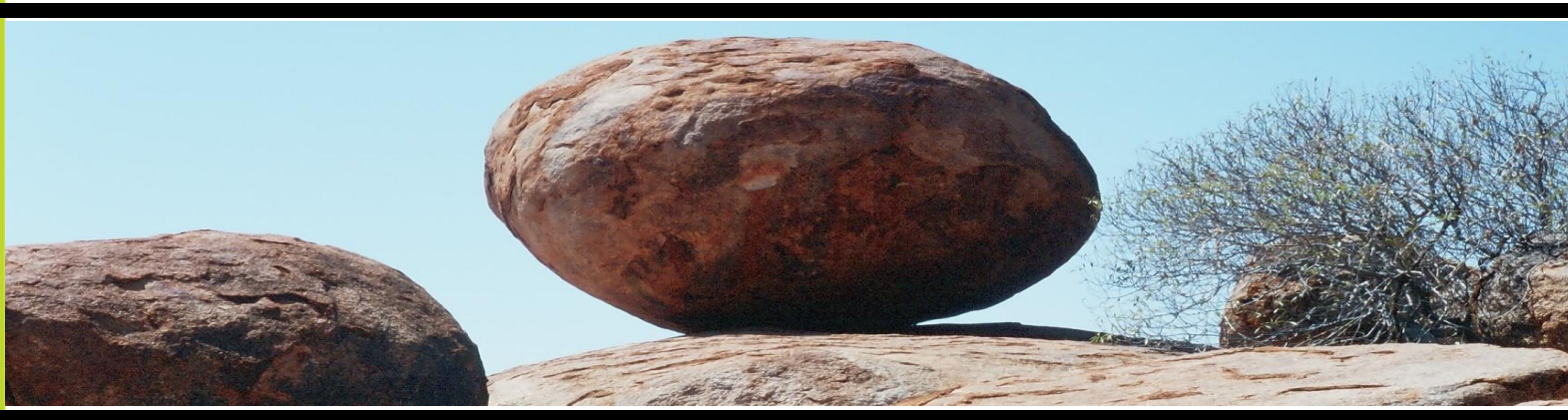


Guiding Principles



1. Institutional principles

- Good Governance
- Integrated decision-making & multi-stakeholder approaches
- Enhanced organizational and personal capacity



2. Economic principles

- Recognition of the value of goods & services
- Enabling environment for investment
- Recognition of the role of the market

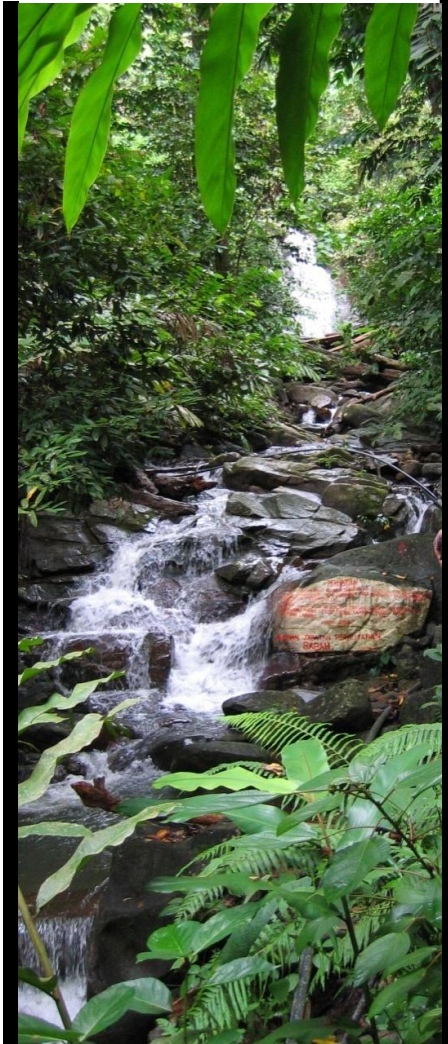


3. Social & cultural principles

Recognition and maintenance of social
& cultural values



4. Environmental Principles



- Maintenance of environmental sustainability and forest health
- Conservation of biological diversity and genetic resources
- Integrated landscape or watershed approach
